

Smells That Repel Dogs

*Citrus

Mix concentrated lemon juice with water for a repellent spray that is safe to use almost anywhere.

*Chili Pepper

Rub or sprinkle cayenne powder and dried chili powder directly on the area where dogs are chewing. You can also mix it with water for a spray solution that will repel dogs. Although non-toxic, these powders can irritate the eyes, nose, and throat.

*Vinegar

Spray directly on the brace or areas where dogs are chewing.

*Rubbing Alcohol

Spray directly on areas where dogs are chewing.

*Bitter Apple Spray (by Grannick)

Spray on areas where dogs are chewing. Can be purchased at most pet supply stores.

*Equine Crib Guard Spray (by EQyss)

Spray on areas where dogs are chewing. Can be purchased at tack shops. Typically used for horses that crib, and supposed to taste worse than the Bitter Apple Spray.
